## **Enrollment Guidelines for Grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>**

Many students transfer to the parochial schools in the upper grades and they do so for a variety of reasons. Experience has taught us that students can make an excellent transition to our school if they are made aware of some of the differences in learning environments and they have the opportunity to ask all the questions that they may have.

Therefore, in addition to the paperwork required of all new students, we require the following:

1. The parents must provide Good Shepherd Parish School with the name and telephone number of the student's principal or counselor at his/her current school. We do make contact with that person to verify that they are a student in good standing and that there have been no behavior violations which would prohibit them from being enrolled at Good Shepherd. (ex. Drugs or weapons violations).
2. All prospective 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> graders must be interviewed by the principal of Good Shepherd Parish School. At that time they should have their most recent report cards and any other documents that they feel show their academic ability.
3. Following the interview with the principal, all prospective 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> graders must spend 1-2 hours in the classrooms with students of their own grade.

Every effort is made to arrange these interviews and classroom visits at times that don't overly interrupt the school time of the student.
